A2. All vendors wishing to do business with the City of Columbus must have an active contract compliance number with the Office of Diversity and Inclusion.

A Columbus Office of Diversity and Inclusion contract compliance application must be submitted and approved for the City of Columbus to do business with your company. To complete the compliance process, please follow the steps below.

1. Go to Vendor Services at <https://columbusvendorservices.powerappsportals.com/>
2. Select Login, then enter your email and password created at registration
3. Once in Vendor Services, select the **Contract Compliance** tile
4. Select **Complete Questionnaire** Icon
5. Select the **Start** Questionnaire Button
6. Answer Each Question and Select **Forward** to move to the next question
7. At the last question (Forward is no longer available), select **End** to Submit your Questionnaire.
