<p>Specification states that a set of outriggers is required but no outriggers are generally required for a SST40. Outriggers are only required for a VST40 which has a material handler or jib, which requires the outriggers due to the lifting capacity. Is this an error in the bid or do you want a set of outriggers added to this even though they are not required on this model.</p>	<p>The bucket truck must come with one set of outriggers in between the cab and body. Torsion bars will <u>NOT</u> be accepted as a replacement of outriggers.</p>
<p>The body requirements are stainless and I was wondering if a fiberglass body substitution would be acceptable? They fulfill the purpose of not rusting or corroding.</p>	<p>The service body must be constructed of stainless steel. Fiberglass, aluminum, or non stainless steel bodies will <u>NOT</u> be accepted.</p>
